





BRUNEI DARUSSALAM General Economic Outlook




Brunei Darussalam's GDP Year-On-Year Performance Q1 2023 - Q1 2024










1. EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION NEW CAMPUS FOR UNIVERSITI ISLAM SULTAN SHARIF ALI [UNISSA]




- Located at Kampung Piasau-Piasau, Temburong district
- Budget allocation: BND\$100 millon under Brunei's 11th National Development Plan
- 310 hactare
- A new landmark for islamic teachings development and a new hub for Islamic learning higher centre in the region
- Status:
 - 1st phase: Earthworks and Infrastructure Works

2. RESIDENTIAL - NATIONAL HOUSING SCHEME KAMPUNG TANAH JAMBU [Phase 7]



- Located at Kampung Tanah Jambu, Brunei-Muara district
- Consists of 950 terraces
- Started in May 2023 under the 11th National Development Plan
- Status: Expected to be completed by 2025

3. WAY FORWARD TO SMART NATION INTRODUCTION OF UNIFIED SMART METER SYSTEM [USMS]



- The Unified Smart Meter System is an on-going project since October 2022; which involves the installation of smart meters in around 200,000 households.
- The project aimed at improving energy and water management across the nation.
- Additionally, to create a more efficient, sustainable, and engaged energy ecosystem for its citizens.
- One of the efforts to develop a digital payment hub to create a conducive business ecosystem in Brunei, particularly in the context of a Smart Nation, targeting a 20 per cent reduction in national greenhouse gas emissions by 2030.

4. Brunei is targeting 30% renewable energy in total power generation mix by 2035, with 200 MWp of solar energy by 2025.



- In October 2024, Hengyi Industries launched their solar project (Project SINAR) at Pulau Muara Besar, which is set to become the largest in Brunei upon the completion of its first phase in April 2025.
- The Project SINAR aims to reach a total capacity of 476 MWp over three phases, which would
 equate to the power required for over 120,000 households.
- Some other major active solar installations in Brunei include;
 - -**Tenaga Suria Brunei** (launched in 2010) with a capacity of 1.2MWp -**Brunei Shell Petroleum** (launched in 2021) – with a capacity of 3.3 MWp
- Upcoming projects include a 30 MWp solar plant in Subok by 2025, along with additional installations planned in other districts.
